### It's all about the Game

**Golf Croquet Handicap Cards** (Sue Huddy, Club GC Handicapper) - On the 2 April 2017 a new system of handicapping came in to play and since then, only the new white handicap cards may be used in any event requiring card usage. This includes our ladder challenge. If you have not done so yet, please bring your green card to Sue, so she can make your transfer, as soon as you can. Sue is required to submit all our stats to HQ as soon as she can.

At the end of any month, in which you use your card, please take it to Sue for checking, just until we're all filling them in correctly. If you have any doubts about this, or need any help, come see Sue anytime. Remember that, any time you use your card, it is your responsibility to fill them in correctly. Also remember to check that an opponent has filled their card in correctly (obviously, only for the game you played against them), before you initial theirs.

**The NorthWood Friendlies** are just around the corner, Sunday 28th May to be precise. This year we will be the host. Please look to the notice board for details, and make sure you are included, this one is fun.

**GC Club Champion Ladder Challenge** - this finishes one week before the Club AGM. Get on the ladder now.

**Uniforms** - the Committee has decided that members playing competition are to wear a red or white polo shirt. The Club will not be purchasing these shirts, so members can purchase their own shirt and take it to *EmbroidMe Prospect* at 316 Main North Road, Prospect (phone: 83429422). They will sew on the Clubs logo at a cost of approx. \$19.80. Note, if you have purchased a red shirt the logo should be white; or a red logo for a white shirt. If you purchase a shirt at EmbroidMe the cost of the logo is \$10.

Golf Croquet Rules - Did you know: it is important not to play the wrong ball or play out of turn. If this does happen then your opponent can choose whether or not to replace the balls or leave them where they are, and choose which ball to restart with. For example: if yellow was played (wrongly) after blue, your opponent can choose to continue with either the black or the blue ball. (In Singles if a player plays there partner ball by mistake the ball is put back where it was and the correct partner ball is played, no penalty. In Doubles if the ball belongs to the striker's partner, no points are scored for any ball, the ball and any other ball moved are replaced and the correct ball is played, no penalty). A hoop run by the wrong ball does not count as a hoop point.
